CONVENTION TIME

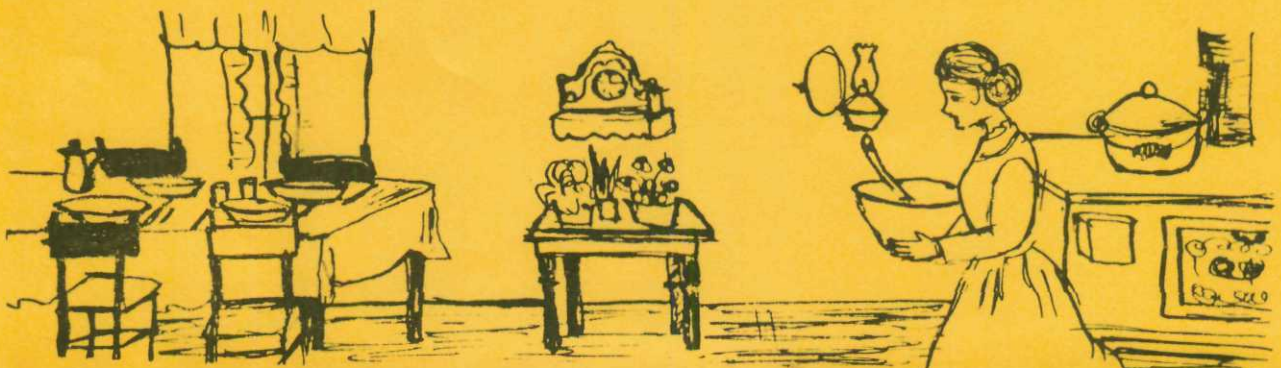
The Fourteenth International Convention of the American Historical Society of Germans from Russia will be held on June 14-19. Please register now, if you haven't already done so.
